Kyoto International University (KIU) was founded in 1989. In 2003, KIU and the KIU Academy high school were granted government recognition as non-profit educational institutions (Kakusho Gakkou Houjin).



KIU's purpose is to educate individuals through a Biblical worldview and in the western-style liberal arts tradition.



KIU's vision is to be recognized as an exemplary Christian university in Japan.

## Departments

### International Studies

### Biological Sciences

The general education component provides a solid foundation in the liberal arts that prepares individuals to move into their major field of study. Also, the foreign language requirement includes English for Japanese students and Japanese for internationals.

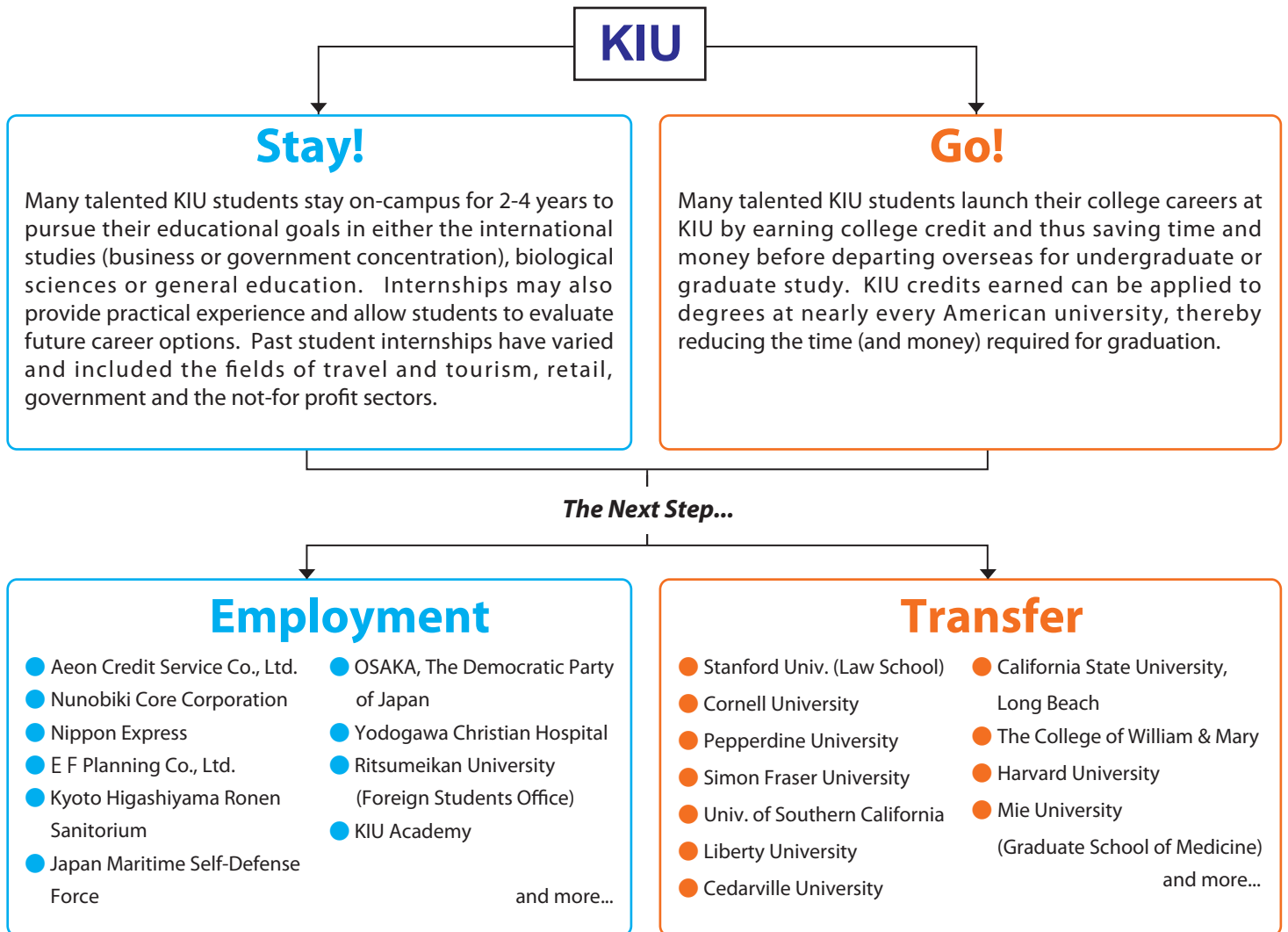
